

Smart ESAC Participant Terms of Use

Last Updated: July 18th, 2016

The Smart ESAC (Early Screening for Autism and Communications Disorders) Application (the "Application") is operated and provided to you by Autism Navigator, LLC, potentially in coordination with your health care provider or another sponsoring organization ("Sponsoring Organization"). The following terms and conditions, together with any documents they expressly incorporate by reference (the "Terms of Use") govern your access to and use of the Application, including any content, functionality and services offered on, through or in combination with the Application.

Please read these Terms of Use carefully before you start to use the Application. By logging in, entering or using the Application, or by clicking to accept or agree to the Terms of Use when that option is made available to you, you accept and agree to be bound and abide by these Terms of Use. You may use the Application only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms of Use. If you do not want to agree to these Terms of Use, you must not access or use the Application.

By consenting to these Terms of Use, you agree that you are providing your legal signature in electronic form, to the extent allowed by law. Children under thirteen (13) years of age are not permitted to submit information directly to the Application. By registering with the Application and accessing your account, you are attesting and warranting that you are the legal guardian of any child(ren) whose information you provide through the account and that all information is provided directly by you as the legal guardian.

Definitions

Provider. A healthcare provider, early intervention provider, child care provider or other service provider that you authorize to access and contribute information to your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal.

Authorized Viewer. An Authorized Viewer is an individual that you allow to view information in your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal (read-only).

Personal Health Information. Personal Health Information includes any information about you or your child(ren) in the FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal. Personal Health Information includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Your name and contact information, such as your address, phone number, or email address
- Your child's Smart ESAC screening results
- Any family history information you chose to provide
- Demographic information, such as your age, gender, ethnicity, and occupation
- The frequency, location (home or office) and status of services provided to your child(ren)
- Computer information, such as your IP address and "cookie" preferences
- Information about your use of online courses and tools that are recommended for you

Changes to the Terms of Use

We may make changes to the Terms of Use from time to time in our sole discretion. All changes are effective immediately when we post them. Your continued use of the Application following the posting of such changes means that you accept and agree to the changes. You should check this page from time to time so that you are aware of any changes to the Terms of Use, as they are binding on you.

Access to the Application

Upon registration, Autism Navigator grants you a limited, nonexclusive, non-transferable, revocable right to utilize and access the Application in a manner consistent with these Terms of Use. As part of the FIRST WORDS® Project Parent Portal, you can give permission for Providers to view and add Personal Health Information about you and your child(ren). You may use the FIRST WORDS Project Portal to share certain Personal Health Information with these Providers. You may use the FIRST WORDS Project Portal to communicate with these Providers.

Your decision to use the Portal is entirely voluntary. You may remove any Provider's access to your FIRST WORDS Project Portal by using the options found under "My Account". However, copies of your Personal Health Information previously disclosed to such Providers and incorporated into such Provider's records, if any, may remain in such records. FIRST WORDS Project cannot, and has no obligation to, remove such information from the Provider's records.

FIRST WORDS Project relies on the Providers authorized by you to confirm that they are qualified to use the Portal. FIRST WORDS Project is not responsible for any Provider who misidentifies his or herself or misuses your Protected Health Information. FIRST WORDS Project's sole liability and sole responsibility shall be to disable the access of any entity or individual that FIRST WORDS Project learns misidentified themselves or misused your Personal Health Information. FIRST WORDS Project is relying on you to verify and review that the Providers you invite into the FIRST WORDS Project Portal are serving you and your child. FIRST WORDS Project does not examine the credentials of, perform background checks on, or give its endorsement to any Provider.

Authorized Viewers

You may grant access to your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal account to one or more Authorized Viewers. You may grant an Authorized Viewer access to your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal account. When you grant access to an Authorized Viewer, the Authorized Viewer will have "read-only" access to your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal account, i.e., the Authorized Viewer shall be authorized to view your FIRST WORDS Project Parent Portal information ONLY, and will NOT be able to communicate with or otherwise engage in transactions with your Providers. Authorized Viewers will NOT be able to complete a Smart ESAC screening questionnaire or participate in monthly e-Monitoring. Only you will be able to add or terminate Providers. You are solely responsible for verifying the identity of, and monitoring the use by, any Authorized Viewer you select. FIRST WORDS Project has no responsibility or liability in connection with any access to, or use of, your account and information by any Authorized Viewer.

Smart ESAC Participant Privacy Policy

The Smart ESAC Application (the "Application") is operated and provided to you by Autism Navigator, LLC, potentially in coordination with your health care provider or another sponsoring organization ("Sponsoring Organization"). Autism Navigator respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through compliance with this Privacy Policy ("Policy"). This Policy explains how we handle the Personal Information we collect in connection with your use of the Application and how we use and disclose that information. "Personal Information" for purposes of this Policy means information that identifies you, such as your name, address, phone number, fax number or email address.

This Privacy Policy is also subject to the provisions of our Terms of Use. Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, you should not use the Application. By accessing or using this Application or by clicking to accept or agree to the Policy when that option is made available to you, you accept and agree to be bound and abide by this Privacy Policy. This Policy may change from time to time. Your continued use of the Application after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the Policy periodically for updates.

What Personal Information We Collect

We collect information that you provide directly to us. For example, we collect information when you create an account or otherwise communicate with us and when you use the Application to respond to survey questions or use other tools offered through the Application.

Disclosure to Third-Parties
